January 1, 2023—Begins tuition reimbursement requests period for courses ending AFTER July 1, 2024

If you have completed courses and wish to apply that credit, move over a column on the salary schedule, and get a salary increase, this is a reminder that **OCTOBER 10** is the deadline for submitting your information to the district. If you completed the course approval process prior to taking the courses, you must then complete the salary advancement form and submit your official transcripts to Eric Demkin no later than OCTOBER 10. Otherwise, you'll have to wait a full year to see your learning reflected in your earnings.
