Thomas stated that those positions are compensated and are voluntary...if they don't want to continue with the role, they can return to the classroom. Another issue involves IA's and the work they are being asked to do...There are a wide range of tasks being assigned and some are wondering what is and isn't in the job description. V. Fedeli can forward this information to share. And the final concern involves members' confusion about seeking LMEA vs HR for support when issues arise. A. Avellino shared that If there are questions, members can always ask an officer or building rep for assistance. LMEA can be there from the start to work with the member and HR or we are here to guide people if they don't know where to start. It is helpful if we can be involved from the beginning, but we can also help members at any time in the process. Each case is different and depends on the members involved, but we are always here to help!
